1. Define & provide evidence of teacher quality

- Identify quality assessments of teacher performance
- Involve others in defining teacher quality

2. Work with external alliances to advance Teacher Quality

- Establish a relationship with Education Minnesota
- Enhance our relationship with BOT
- Promote the Minnesota Alliance for Education
- Develop a “Friends of MACTE” process
- Engage in public relations activities to advance teacher quality
- Meet with administrators

3. Serve as a support system for teacher education

- Design and sponsor Minnesota Teacher Education Congresses
- Keep members informed about the state and national climate
- Support institutional understanding and use of quality assessments
- Establish a forum/clearinghouse for sharing
- Provide web based resources or links
- Establish and maintain a statewide web based forum/resource
